

Rievaulx to Helmsley walk through Rye Dale

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one from Rievaulx back to the Feathers Hotel in Helmsley

Start/end: Permissive paths will take you from the Feather Hotel in Helmsley to the start of the walk at Rievaulx, or use two cars or a taxi

Distance: 9 miles **Time:** 4 ½ hours

Route highlights: You'll start close to scenic Rievaulx Terrace with views of ruined Rievaulx Abbey. The walk crosses a historic stone bridge, passes through woodland and open farmland. In the village of Old Byland you'll find a fine green, at one end of which are the stocks and at the other an old Norman font. Follow the Cleveland Way back to Helmsley.
