



Stonehenge and Old Sarum walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one from Salisbury to Amesbury via Old Sarum and Stonehenge.

Start/end: From the George Hotel in Amesbury catch a bus to Salisbury then you'll walk back to the hotel

Distance: 12 ½ miles (one way)

Time: 5 hours

Route highlights: A delightful linear walk from Salisbury to Amesbury via Old Sarum and Stonehenge, passing through pretty villages and a prehistoric landscape.

You'll also see Salisbury Cathedral, medieval buildings and earthworks, plus plenty of nature among the woodlands and grasslands.
