



North Yorkshire moorland walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one in the moorland near Thirsk.

Start/end: A 25 minute drive from the Golden Fleece to Hawnby Bridge

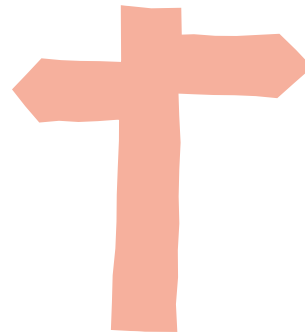
Distance: 10 ½ miles

Time: 5 hours

Route highlights: A very varied walk across moorland and through forests with splendid views. The tiny village of Hawnby is mentioned twice in the Domesday Book.

The walk will take you to what locals call 'Hidden Valley', past streams and up some steep hills. It's a remote and beautiful walk, well worth the trip from Thirsk.
