

River Great Ouse & St Ives walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one in St Ives, Cambridgeshire.

Start/end: Pick up the walk around the corner from The Golden Lion Hotel

on Bridge Street **Distance:** 9 miles

Time: 4 ½ hours

Route highlights: This circular route is ideal for all the family and explores both sides of the River Great Ouse to the west of the historic quayside. The walk visits nature reserves and a working 18th-century water mill, Houghton Mill. You'll spot historic thatched houses, shady willow trees and plenty of riverside wildlife. Finish the walk by crossing the 15th century bridge, with its unusual chapel.
