The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one in North Norfolk, close to the King William IV.


Start/end: A 5 minute drive to Ringstead from the King William IV

Distance: 7 miles

Time: 3 hours

Route highlights: A well-marked Norfolk trails circular walk using part of the Pedder's Way long distance path. You'll be walking on part of an ancient path that may even pre-date the Romans. Courtyard Farm is a haven for nature with wildflower meadows. The next stage has great views over the North Norfolk Coast. And the walk finishes by passing a windmill.
