

Guildford and the River Wey walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one from Guildford town centre.

Start/end: From the Kings Arms and Royal Hotel it's a short train ride or drive to Guildford to start the walk

Distance: 4 ½ miles

Time: 2 hours

Route highlights: On this walk you'll see Guildford Cathedral, Henley Fort, Guildford Castle and ruined St Catherine's Chapel. Author Lewis Carroll lived here and you'll go past his grave.

And on a clear day you'll have views across the hills to London, including Wembley Stadium, the London Eye and the City in the distance.
