

Llanymynech and Offa's **Dyke walk**

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one in the Welsh borders, not far from the Royal Oak in Welshpool.

Start/end: Llanymynech is a 15 minute drive up the A83 from the Royal

Oak Hotel

Distance: 6 ½ miles

Time: 3 ¼ hours

Route highlights: The walk starts exploring Llanymynech's industrial heritage then rises to trace Offa's Dyke Path marking the

England/Wales border along a high wooded scarp with huge views up the Tanat Valley. You'll drop down

again to find the relict

Montgomeryshire Canal, a sturdy aqueduct and tranquil return to the start point.
