

Secret Essex walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one 10 minutes drive from the Saracen's Head in Great Dunmow.

Start/end: A 10 min drive from the Saracen's Head, the walk starts and

ends in Duton Hill

Distance: 6 ½ miles

Time: 3 1/4 hours

Route highlights: This delightful circular walk highlights one of Essex's secret corners and passes through countryside and villages. You'll see a watermill, a historic 12th century church in Little Easton, the remains of Tilty Abbey, and Easton Lodge, once home to Edward VII's mistress.
