



Great Oxendon Tunnel and Jurassic Way walk

The Ramblers is Britain's walking charity. They remove barriers so everyone can enjoy walking. Members can join thousands of group walks and access a library of routes, such as this one in Market Harborough.

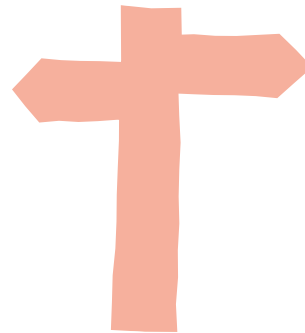
Start/end: Walk a few minutes from the Three Swans Hotel and join the walk at the River Welland.

Distance: 8 miles

Time: 3 hours

Route highlights: A circular route from Market Harborough, starting with easy walking along the Brampton Valley Way, a disused railway with a tunnel to walk through, then two villages, fields, and finishing beside the River Welland. Oxendon Tunnel is an old railway tunnel, 418 metres long. You'll walk part of the long-distance Jurassic Way, and pass English Civil War sites too.
